2024 Art In the Porongurup Entry Terms and Conditions

1. Competition is in two sections: **OPEN** All ages
YOUTH 15 years and under
2. Youth will be judged in both sections.
3. Entry forms, including postal forms, must be received by **5 pm on 22 March, 2024**. All sections of the form must be completed and marked 'for sale' or 'not for sale'.
4. 20% commission on sales goes to the Porongurup Community Association.
5. No more than three entries per person or group. An entry may include multiple pieces with a cohesive theme.
6. Exhibit must be an original work of the artist and not have won a prize in any previous art competition.
7. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure that their work is not subject to libel, defamation of character or in violation of copyright laws.
8. Entry is to be sculptural, broadly defined as a 3-dimensional exhibit.
9. Entry must be durable to withstand display outdoors.
10. Artists are requested not to display personal logos, sponsors or commercial entity around the sculpture. This information/material may be left at the entry desk for display.
11. Artists are responsible for the installation of their works. Please advise co-ordinator if you would like to inspect the site for selection of position or need any assistance with installation. The manner of installation should respect the natural setting of the exhibition site. **Set up times: midday to 4.30pm Thursday 28 March 2024** unless prior arrangement is made.
12. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist at all times. The Porongurup Community Association does not cover malicious damage insurance for any work in the exhibition nor does it insure those persons installing and de-installing works. The Porongurup Community Association holds no responsibility for damage caused to works during transportation to the exhibition site, installation, de-installation and while the works are on display.
13. To protect the environment, artist/s will remove all packaging, tools & equipment from the site when installation and de-installation is complete. Small, loose decorations eg. sparklers, streamers etc must not be used.
14. There will be no access to site between the hours of **5pm – 9am** unless by prior arrangement.
15. The Porongurup Community Association reserves the right to reproduce images of works for promotional, marketing or educational purposes.
16. The Porongurup Community Association reserves the right to reject an exhibit if it does not match the "Terms and Conditions", deemed unsafe or inappropriate.
17. Artwork can be available for sale with a commission of 20% of selling price payable to the Porongurup Community Association. Please include sale price of exhibit on the entry form. Organisers ask that you do not use POA; the exhibit should be marked **For sale** or **Not for sale**.
18. Exhibits can only be removed by artists or purchasers after the presentations on Saturday 6 April, 2024. If unable to collect on this day, please make written arrangements for someone to do so on your behalf. No responsibility will be taken for art works remaining on site after 1pm Saturday 6 April, 2024.
19. Public votes will close at **5pm Friday 5 April, 2024**. The **Awards presentations will be held at midday Saturday 6 April 2024** in the Porongurup Hall with refreshments to follow. Artists, family and friends are welcome.

The Judging Panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Lobbying the Judges will result in instant disqualification.
